# What Parents & Carers Need to Know about

YouTube is a video-sharing social media platform that allows billions of people around the world to watch, share and upload their own videos with a vast range of content – including sport, entertainment, education and lots more. It's a superb space for people to consume content that they're interested in. As a result, this astronomically popular platform has had a huge social impact: influencing online culture on a global scale and creating new celebrities.

### INAPPROPRIATE CONTENT

### CONNECT WITH STRANGERS

YeuTube is a scalar modic platform which allows people to interest with other (usually unknown) users. Account helders can leave comments on my video they have access to, as well or messaging other users affectly. #### SNEAKY SCAMMERS

Propular YeuTube channels regularly have commerce posing as a well-known influencer in the comments section, attempting to lure users into clicking on their phishing links. Scanners impersonate YouTubers by adepting their names and profile integes, and cometimes offer cost gifts or 'get rich quick' schemes. Children may not reelle that these users are not whe they claim to be.

# Advice for Parents & Carers

#### APPLY RESTRICTED MODE

Beatricted Mede is an optional setting that prevents YouTube from showing brainpropriate content (such as drug and dispited doues, graphic visiones and secure dispation) to underage visuones. To prevent your child from character decreas age—independents content on the platform, we would recommend enabling bestricted Mede en each dispite that you'r child uses to access YouTube.

#### CHECK OTHER PLATFORMS
