

PRIMARY SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

Children start primary school at the beginning of the school year in which they become five years of age. A child born between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022 should start school in September 2026.

When to make your application

If your child is due to start reception in September 2026, you must complete and submit your application by **15 January 2026.**

Children with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) must apply by **31 October 2025.**

What you should do before you apply

Starting primary school is an important stage in your child's life. It is essential that you carefully consider which schools to apply to.

You can visit your local schools to help you decide which schools to apply to. Meeting staff at schools and hearing what daily school life is like will really help you decide which school would be best for your child.

You should consider how your child will get to and from school. You will generally be responsible for your child's travel arrangements and any associated costs if you decide that you want your child to go to a school that is not your nearest or catchment area school. See page 39 for further information.

You should also look at:

- the school's website or prospectus (information about how the school operates).
- the school's most recent Ofsted inspection report (www.ofsted.gov.uk/ reports).
- the school's performance results (<u>www.education.</u> <u>gov.uk/schools/</u> <u>performance</u>).

You should also consider the likelihood of being offered places at the schools you prefer. This booklet explains the application process and how school admission decisions are made.

How to apply

If you live in Telford and Wrekin, you must complete the application via the local authority, even if you want to apply to schools outside of the Borough. You should apply online at www.telford.gov.uk/admissions

Once you have submitted your application you will will receive an instant email confirmation. If you would like to make any changes to your application once it is submitted, please email admissions@telford.gov.uk

If you live outside of Telford and Wrekin and want to apply to a school in the Borough you should apply via the local authority where you live. Contact information of nearby local authorities is provided on page 42.
